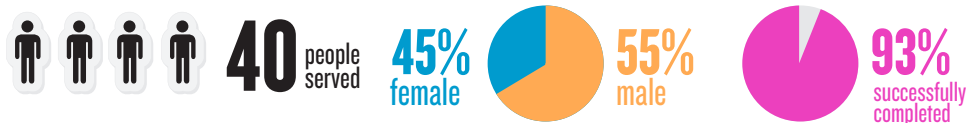


Victim Impact Program

- Most common offenses are speeding + violating a red signal/stop sign

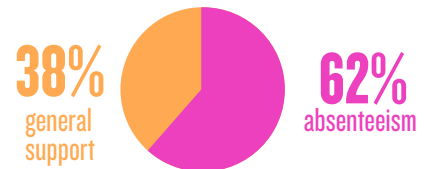
